Ontario pharmacists are able to adapt a patient's prescription in 4 ways

Ontario Regulation

Route
of administration



Dosage
form of the drug
prescribed



Direction
of use of the drug
prescribed



Dose
of the drug
prescribed

Remember!



You can't adapt narcotic, controlled, and monitored drugs or targeted substances



You can't substitute drug in the same class



You must notify the prescriber if you make a clinically significant adaptation
