Route of administration



Dosage form of the drug prescribed



Direction
of use of the drug
prescribed



Dose of the drug prescribed

## Remember!



You can't adapt narcotic, controlled, and monitored drugs or targeted substances



You can't substitute drug in the same class



You must notify the prescriber if you make a clinically significant adaptation
