## "Old" Three-Year General Psychology BA Requirement Checklist

This checklist is an unofficial version of the requirements listed in the undergraduate calendar for 2015-16 and previous to help you track your course requirements. The undergraduate calendar http://ugradcalendar.uwaterloo.ca/ is the final authority on all plan requirements and it is your responsibility to confirm that you meet all the degree requirements set out in the undergraduate calendar for the year of your academic plan. Students typically follow the academic calendar for the year they were admitted to their current Faculty.

Continuation in this academic plan requires a cumulative overall average of $60 \%$ in all courses, and a cumulative average in PSYCH courses of at least 65\%. Eligibility for graduation in the Three-Year General Psychology plan includes successful completion of the following requirements.
