Three-Year General Academic Program

- 15 academic course units (30 courses),

Continuation in this academic plan requires a cumulative overall average of 60% in all courses, and a cumulative average in all PSYCH courses of at least 65%. Eligibility for graduation in the Four-Year General Psychology BA plan includes successful completion of the following requirements:
