Postdoctoral Fellowships in Number Theory

The Waterloo Number Theory group is seeking candidates for two postdoctoral positions to begin on either September 1, 2017, subject to funding. The positions are for a term of two years, with the possibility of an extension to a third. The successful candidates will be expected to engage in research activities and to teach two courses per year within the Faculty of Mathematics at the University of Waterloo.

We are seeking candidates whose research interests are in Diophantine approximation or analytic number theory but all areas of number theory will be considered. More information about our research group can be found here:

Each applicant must submit an application package containing a curriculum vitae, a short statement of research interests and goals, and at least three letters of recommendation, one of which should address the applicant's teaching experience.
