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

LEARN KOREAN LANGUAGE & CULTURE WITH CLASSES OFFERED BY THE KING SEJONG INSTITUTE

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ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Have you always dreamed of travelling to Korea and immersing yourself in its language and culture? The King Sejong Institute at Renison University College offers Korean language and culture courses so you can take the first step toward exploring Korea and all it has to offer. Invest your time by developing the tools that will enable you to join an international community of Korean language learners and speakers.



Our class sizes will remain small so you'll be able to engage with the instructor and your classmates all while practicing your language skills.

COURSE DATES AND TIMES

Each Korean language and culture course consists of one class per week (approx. 4 hours) over a ten-week period. Classes often occur on weekday evenings between 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. Courses are offered in the fall, winter, and spring terms. The deadline for registering is approximately one week prior to the start of classes.

- **Fall classes** start in September
- **Winter classes** start in January
- **Spring classes** start in May

FEES AND REGISTRATION

Each course costs \$250 plus HST. There is a one-time administration fee of \$30 when you sign up for the first time. The King Sejong Institute offers a tuition grant to all students studying non-credit Korean at Renison University College in the amount of \$125.

Once a term has begun, you can withdraw from a course up until the end of the first week of classes, and be refunded 90% of your total tuition. After this date, refunds will not be issued.

COURSES OFFERED

● INTEGRATED KOREAN Level 1, KL 115

This is an introductory course for those who have little to no knowledge of Korean. In this course, students will not only learn how to read and write in Korean, but they will also learn basic verbal skills, such as how to introduce themselves and ask for directions.

● INTEGRATED KOREAN Level 2, KL 125

Continuing from Integrated Korean 1, this course introduces students to more advanced sentence structures and vocabularies. Emphasis is placed on the use of expressions in and for real-life settings.

KOREAN CULTURE CLUB

The King Sejong Institute also hosts a Korean culture club for all students studying non-credit Korean at Renison. Come and learn about Korean culture, pop-culture, food, and much more!
