Health, Safety and Environmental Statement

In alignment with our Strategic Objectives, Renison University College is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for our students, staff, faculty, and visitors while ensuring legislative requirements are met, and safeguarding employee wellness and a positive learning environment.

Together, the Joint Health and Safety Committee (JHSC) and our administration continue to work to remove risks that may impact the health, safety, and wellbeing of those working, studying, or visiting within our facilities thereby protecting our community members from injury or occupational disease. The regular and proactive activities that occur such as workplace inspections, risk assessments, regular monitoring and compliance with legislation ensure that we identify, evaluate and correct potential hazards.

Everyone within Renison must be dedicated to the objective of reducing the risk of injury and ensuring that every reasonable precaution in all circumstances is taken to enable the safety of those within our facility.
