

EMERGENCY SHOWER WEEKLY INSPECTION

Emergency showers flush tepid water, diluting any hazardous materials that may have come into contact with the skin.

WEEKLY REQUIREMENTS

Initial and date in the corresponding box verifying the eyewash station was checked for the following:

- The pathway to the station is clear of all obstructions.
- The shower fixture is free of obstructions in all directions.
- There are no visible leaks from plumbing components.
- The unit is clean.
- To test the emergency shower, flush water until stagnant water from the dead leg is removed.
- Check that the flow of water once activated, can be used without requiring the use of the operator's hands.
- Ensure flap covers are closed.
- Check that signage is visible.

IF PROBLEMS ARE EVIDENT

1. Report the issues to your supervisor immediately.
2. Notify Plant Operations at ext. 33793.
3. Lockout and tag out the station until necessary repairs are carried out.
4. Ensure no hazardous materials are used until repairs are completed.
