 - You can launch all of the videos via LEARN. A few of the longer videos can be downloaded via LEARN and viewed without internet access, but many of the short videos cannot be downloaded. From LEARN, you can launch the videos in YouTube, with optional subtitles.
 - If you view materials via LEARN, you have the option of logging in to Perusall later to respond to the in-line prompts.
