Ran the New York Marathon in 1983 ... now spends most of his running by chasing his 4 grandchildren – his best job ever!



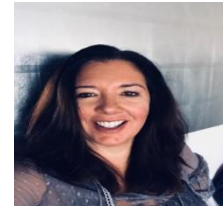
