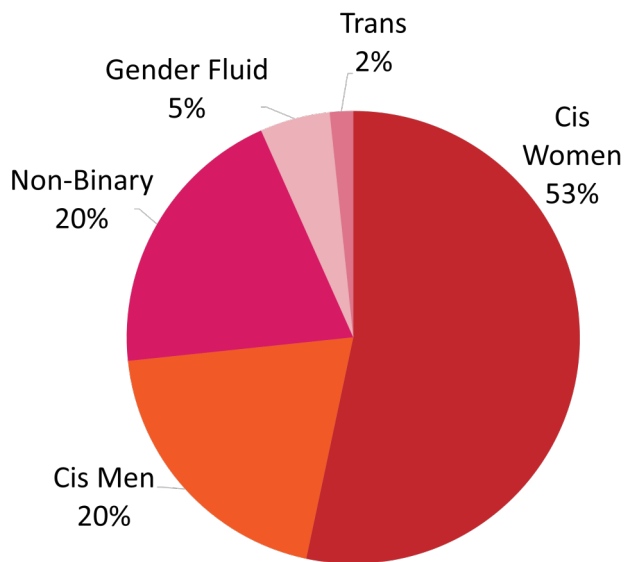
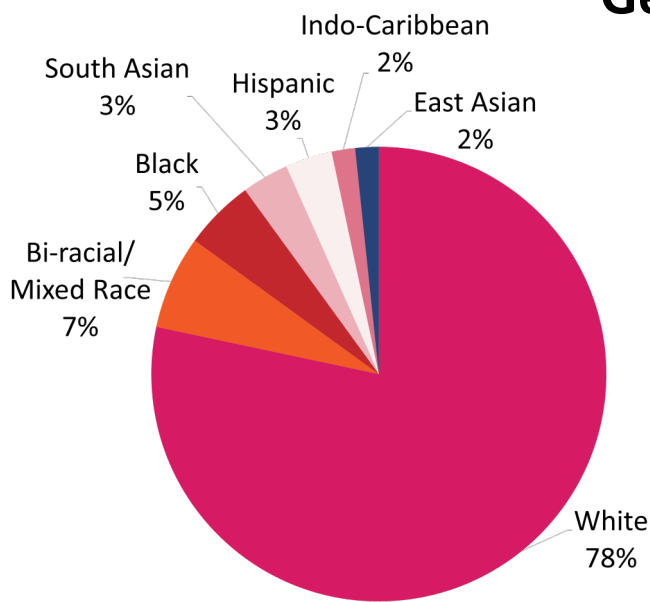




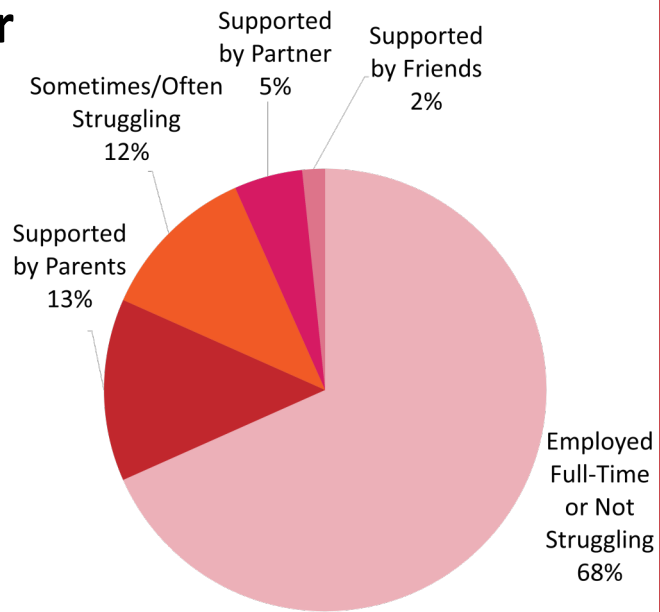

Race



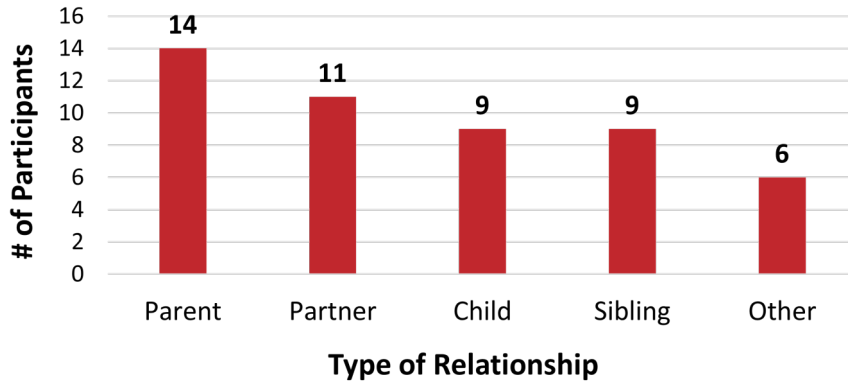

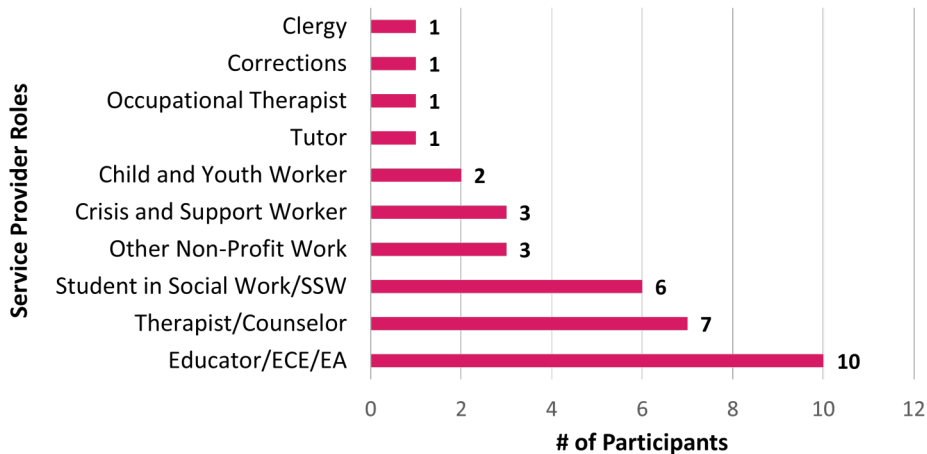
