**Additional Notes:**

- 1) Highly recommended that students take 5 courses per term

AND any AFM course not otherwise required eg to meet degree requirements

**Accounting and Financial Management - Finance Specialization/Recommendations**

The Finance Specialization was removed from the undergraduate calendar effective Fall 2015, and does not apply to the Class of 2020 and beyond. The following lists the recommended courses for students pursuing a career in Finance:

AFM 322, 323, 424, 425, 478; ECON 201, 202\*; plus at least two of AFM 321, 422, 423, 473, 477 – 7 core courses with 2 electives

**New Finance elective opportunities:**

\*AFM 416 Private Equity & Venture Capital is eligible as a Finance elective

\*Two Investment Fund credits qualify as one Finance Specialization elective. Select two of: AFM 328, 329, 428, or 429

\***ECON 202** - Effective Fall 2016, the Economics department will no longer deliver ECON 202. Spring 2016 was the last offering. It has been replaced by a couple of courses including ECON 206 Introduction to Money and Banking 1 and ECON 207 Economic Growth and Development 1. Detailed course information was not available at this time. When it is ready, we will review the course content to determine if ECON 206 is recommended for Finance Students.
