- a) Degree requires successful completion of one AFM specialization: Professional Accountant (CPA), Financial Leadership, Financial Markets, Sustainability, Entrepreneurial Mindset, or Business Analytics.
- b) Professional Accountant (CPA) requirements must complete BAFM core courses, Professional Accountant specialization courses and AFM 341
- c) **Business Analytics** must take AFM 345 or 346, plus any four course from the this list: AFM 323, 341, 345, 346, 347, 423/ACTSC 423, 444, 445, 446, 447, 448 (students may take both AFM 345 and 346, plus any three courses from the above list)
- d) Entrepreneurial Mindset must take BET 320, and BET 340; plus any three of AFM 326, 377, 426, 470, BET 350, 400, 420, 430, 450, 460, 470, 580, ENBUS 203, MGMT 220. AFM 326, 426 (note: these courses are 0.25 weight; you must take two to satisfy one of three requirement). (Other courses may be considered with SAF Advisor approval).
- e) **Sustainability** must take 1 course from the following: ENBUS 102 (*F*), ENVS 195 (*W*), ENVS 220 (*W*), or INDEV 100, plus 2 of the following courses: ENVS 200, ENVS 205, ENVS 220, INDEV 200, plus 3 courses from either option A or B A) ENBUS 310, ENBUS 408 (*F* or *W*), ENBUS 410 (*W*) OR B) ENBUS 202 (*F*), ENBUS 407 (*F*), AFM 485 (other courses may be considered with SAF Advisor approval). Note the terms each course is typically offered. The terms in which courses are offered may change, but this is a guide. You may need to be flexible with when you take electives and specialization courses with the Sustianability specialization depending on course offerings.
- f) **Financial Leadership** must take AFM 434, 478, BET 450, 460, one of AFM 422, AFM 470, or AFM 477, plus one of AFM 485, ENBUS 310, ENBUS 407 (*F*), or ENVS 220 (*W*)
- g) **Financial Markets** must take six courses from list: AFM 276, 322, 324, 326, 328, 329, 377, 422, 423/ACTSC 423, 425, 426, 427, 428, 429, 434, 470, 477, 478, SFM 310, 412, **AFM 326/328/329/426/428/429 (note: these courses are 0.25 weight; you must take two to satisfy one of six requirement)**

Additional Notes:

- 1) Each AFM student is responsible for meeting the AFM degree requirements as set out in the University Calendar.
- 2) "Electives" include: any non-AFM course at UW into which students may enrol, i.e. satisfy pre-reqs, etc. AND any AFM course not otherwise required to meet degree requirements.
- 3) Students are required to complete a primary specialization and may opt to choose a secondary Specialization utilizing the elective credits.
- 4) Course offerings for each term are subject to change by instructor availability and other variables; this document is to be used as a guide only. Always consult the Schedule of Classes each term during course selection. Academic Advisors may not have additional information on course offerings.
