		Speaker: We must approve a VPA for Fall 2020 and Winter 2021. All of
		their platforms have been posted on the Facebook group. Floor is
		opened to those wanting to discuss who they would like to nominate.
		CRO: Sumaya was the only one running for Fall and Winter, Reggie and
		Matthew ran for Fall and Noor ran for Winter alone. As you can see, the
		platforms are in the agenda, and you can ask any questions of clarification
	_	as well to help determine who you would like to vote for.
		BUGS: Really liked Reginald's presentation for Fall 2020, based on the
		way they presented.
		VPF: He had great points on expanding the First Year Rep portfolio, and
		[Reginald] would be able to make it a much better role for first years by
		hearing it by the [First Year representatives].  Speaker: Just to clarify [CRO], Reggie is only running for Fall?
		CRO: Correct, due to his co-op sequence.
		Speaker: Does that only leave the Board with 2 candidates for the Winter
	<b>—</b>	term?
		CRO: Yes, it would be either Noor or Summaya.
		VPF: Would you like to discuss pro's and con's of the candidates?
		MNS: I really appreciate [Matthew] because of his new ideas, for example
		with the Newsletter, which is something SciSoc has not previously done.
		His prior experience with VPI is also an asset. He would also be a great
		voice from SciSoc from a physical science rather than a life science.
		VPF: Matthew was an exec back in Fall 2019 and does have prior
		experience with SciSoc.
		CRO: Having been a prior VPA, sure you might want to accomplish
		something, but there is no guarantee you can do it. I do think [Reginald]
		presented a much more feasible goal, trying to fix the whole concept of
		how events from VPA are run. I've never heard anyone trying to fix this
		issue before. Also he is in Environmental Sciences,
		MNS: Where are all their platforms again?
		CRO: They are on the agenda and facebook groups.

	Speaker: All their platforms were linked to the chat by [PhysClub], thank you PhysClub In terms of continuity, it appears that Summaya is the
	only candidate running for both terms. To bring everyone up to date, the
	WUSA hiring committee and Board have indicated that despite being
	lovely, was red flagged by WUSA, due to involvement for the wrong
	reason and introduction to conflicts among teams. She has never been
	involved with SciSoc, and this information comes purely and unbiasedly
	from WUSA. To confirm, [CRO], none of the other candidates would be
	able to run both terms?
	CRO: Yes, Noor only ran for one term as it best fits her schedule, and
	Reggie is also unable to because of co-op. However, VPA is a role that is
	less crucial in terms of continuity.
	VPF: I believe Summaya could do well, however in terms of commitment,
	I am not sure that she can fully commit to the role, and I personally know
	it is a lot of work, I wish we had asked her what else she has on her plate
	for that term.
	Speaker: She mentioned she would sit on the Student Council for next
	term. Would the Board like to discuss candidates for each term
	separately?
	VPF: Should we discuss Fall first?
	Speaker: Sure! Does anyone want to bring forward who they recommend
	or nominate?
	CRO: I think Reggie would be an excellent candidate for the role, he has
	been involved a lot in SciSoc. Also, Matthew still handed in his form late,
	despite having an extension. Matthew also didn't know BUGS gave out
_	lab coats and goggles, despite having been an exec for SciSoc.
╚	MNS brings up a mistake in Matthew's platform regarding the formatting
	of which term he is running for, which was readdressed to confirm he is
_	running for Fall 2020.
	PhysClub: The only impression I have of her is based on what Zahra said
_	from the Board, can anyone discuss their impression?
	VPF: She did discuss a lot of experience with the Student Council, and
	many other student initiatives. She had a lot of ideas on students studying
	in groups, but we were unsure of how this would work.
	Speaker: She was very well spoken. A potential conflict was that she sits
_	on other Boards, which is a conflict of interest for our Board.
<b>_</b>	BUGS: She did mention she wants to bring together students in
	programs. However, I find that this isn't a common issue among our

programs in Science. This is the exact reason we have these clubs, and I
didn't understand the incentive of this.
BSA: We have a lot of programs and even Science Cluster programs, and
hence we do have support for these possibilities.
MNS: To be honest, her platform is all 3 points, but this is all really just
one point about engaging students, which isn't really even the VPA role,
so I don't know how I feel about her platform.
CRO: I think this is just because she doesn't have prior experience with
SciSoc and what VPA does.
BUGS: I am reading on Reggie, and I really like his point on initiating
events for co-op students in Fall, to help them find resources. Planning
beforehand would be a great idea and less a lot of stress.
At this point, 29 minutes had passed in the ZOOM meeting, and because
of limited time, the Speaker restarted the meeting in order to let Vanessa
present her running for VPE for Fall 2020

		Has done SciSoc 3 terms, and has worked under the current VPF, and has doen accountant meetings, as well as cheque assigning, and working with mailing cheques as well. Also oversees the external accounts as well.
		With her previous experience, she would be a great candidate.
		Wants to discuss a new Public concept for Budgets, so students can
		access them as well, in order to allow students to determine what
		students are funding with their Science Society fee. This template would be available in the office and online.
		Also is interesting in digitizing the records for SciSoc in order to have less clutter and overall easier access to these records.
		Finding a way to digitize records and the way cheque requests are submitted.
		Also, to adjust departmental clubs' feedback systems in order to ensure that students are able to provide valuable feedback to make sure we are
		catering to the student body and accepting those requests. We can store this feedback to make all of our events better within SciSoc and the departmental clubs as well.
		The Board applauds Vanessa and begins the question period.
		VPF: For digitizing records, do you have plans for digitizing cheque requests as well?
		Vanessa: We have been doing this slightly due to COVID-19, and we are looking at ways to have the execs signatures to do this faster in a digital format.
		Speaker: Question of clarification , why are you only running for Fall, would you be interested in running for Winter 2021?
		Vanessa: I already have a commitment for Winter 2021, and feel it is
		unfair to sign up to run as an exec during a term I already have plans for. I will be on campus, and can definitely make transition purposes easier for whoever is running for Winter 2021.
		Speaker: That is very respectable thank you. Here is my fun question, what's been a memorable experience or something you've learned because of SciSoc?
		Vanessa: It's really great how we've been able to put people together, see people try for Medical School, Robotics and more.
		VPF: In terms of the special budget report itself, who would you want to work on that?

Vanessa: I want to work with the Finance associates and execs of SciSoc
so we all know where the money is going so we can better address it.
Speaker asks if there are any questions and wishes Vanessa a great day.
Speaker: Does anyone want to discuss who they would wish to nominate?
CRO: Osanda has also expressed that she can also run for Fall 2020 as
well.
Speaker: In terms of Winter, we only have one candidate, but we must discuss for Fall?
VPF: Vanessa had a lot of work on Science initiatives, and can focus on
communication, and Osanda wants a more sustainable initiative. Hence, if

MNS: Would Vanessa be able to transition well?
VPF: They are both very quick learners and great and fast.
BUGS: Would people even do the feedback form? BUGS was unable to
advertise that successfully. That might not be able to implement that. I
really like Osanda's points a lot more. I don't see the feedback form
having the effect [Vanessa] would like.
VPF: I still think it's valuable feedback, because of the fact that it provides
feedback.
PhysClub: If there isn't a new method of feedback, the point isn't really
valuable due to the new nature.
Speaker: Would anyone like to put forward a motion?
BUGS: I put forward Osanda for Fall 2020 and Winter 2021.
VPF: I want to suggest the fact that it is a big role, and it is quite possible
for one person to get tired out after a term. I don't want to let that
happen.

	Speaker: We can now discuss the Departmental Club Budget Remainder,
	if MNS would like to present their update.
	MNS: Our leftover funding could be used to donate at least some of it
	towards fighting the COVID-19 pandemic, and the only thing we can do
_	right now is to be able to fund this goal.
	VPF: And I have talked to the accountant about this donation.
	MNS: I have worked on this document for a while, in order to make it
	easy to understand. Before I begin, please know that your club does not
	have to participate. The donation plan has 5 points, it donates to the 3
	local hospitals. When a doctor changes rooms from a COVID-19 patient, they have to change PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) twice! Region-
	Ready is a new initiative in order to make funding for the 3 local hospitals
	to support their COVID-19 patients. We can direct what we want them to
	purchase with the money, and furthermore, we can use this as a one time
	payment. Doing a direct deposit results in no percentage loss for the
	transaction fee, so it is important that we try to maximize our donation.
	There are many students living in Waterloo, and it is important to give
	back to the community, and help prevent the spread of this virus. There
	are many tools our University has to be able to give back to the
	community as well, such as 3D printing to help as well.
	Speaker: I believe we have to obtain approval from WUSA and from the
	general Student population to inform them we are donating the money.
	VPF: We do not have to do this, but it would be a kind initiative.
	VPA: Yes, we could create a feedback form in order to do this effectively
_	(VPA and Speaker nod).
	Speaker: The President would be able to obtain more information from
	WUSA regarding what is possible and what is not possible from the
	WUSA council.
u	MNS: We need each club to go back and discuss what each club wants to
	donate, if at all, can I see a visual perspective as to what each club wants to donate?
	VPF: Would you want clubs to donate from carry over?

┙	MNS: I do not want clubs to touch their carry over, please do not do this
	only donate anything remaining from COVID-19 cancellations.
	WatRox: I think that's a great idea, and I'll let you guys know from my
