

# Policy 42, Prevention and Response to Sexual Violence



#### Process

- Policy and Protocol drafted with advice of Provost's Advisory Committee on Equity (PACE)
- PACE is comprised of student government representatives, faculty and staff representation and senior managers
- Extensive consultation before, during and after draft policy was prepared
- > 45 meetings



### Key Issues

- Sexual violence behaviours on a continuum (Areas of concern: human rights, criminal and OHSA related)
- 2. Key Requirements
  - 1. Awareness and prevention
  - Support for individuals affected by sexual violence
  - 3. Administrative processes to address complaints
  - 4. Resources for implementing Policy
- 3. Mandatory review in three years





#### How?

- Policy 33 to continue to address sexual harassment complaints (being revised)
- Policy 42 for other types of sexual violence
  - sexual assault
  - stalking
  - indecent exposure
  - voyeurism
  - sexual exploitation





## Policy 42

- Policy
  - Articulates commitment
    - Prevention
      - Details in a training and education plan
    - Addressing complaints
      - Procedural fairness
      - Support for those involved particularly those with supervisory responsibilities
- The Response Protocol
  - Procedures

  - Plan for implementation
