1. University of Waterloo	Senate Bylaw 3	A bylaw detailing the procedures for selection and election of Senate members.
2. University of Toronto	Election Guidelines	A guideline document detailing the rules for university governance elections (e.g., for Governing Council and related bodies), including nomination rules, campaign rules, voting and counting procedures, by-elections, oversight mechanisms, and timeline templates.
3. McMaster University	Senate Bylaw (5-9)	This document defines the structure, powers, and responsibilities of the Senate and other governing bodies. Faculty-specific bylaws are also available, outlining internal governance and committee structures.
