All work for the show must be handcrafted, designed, altered, embellished, or manipulated by the applicant and applicant must have a vision loss.

Applicants must be 18 years or older. Applications will be accepted on a first come, first served basis until all spots are filled. Applicants will be notified of the acceptance of their application within 3 weeks of it being submitted.

Exhibitors will be provided with a 3' by 5' table and 2 chairs. If a display sign, table cover and/or skirt are needed, they are the responsibility of the exhibitor.

Exhibitors are welcome to sell their work but will be responsible for collecting money, providing change and dealing with tax requirements themselves.

Exhibitors agree to:

- allow the use of their name, photographs or logo in any promotion material
- set-up for the show by 12:00 p.m. and not to take down before 1.30 p.m.
- be responsible for security of own display
