Fall 2017: *Cultural Identities Today*

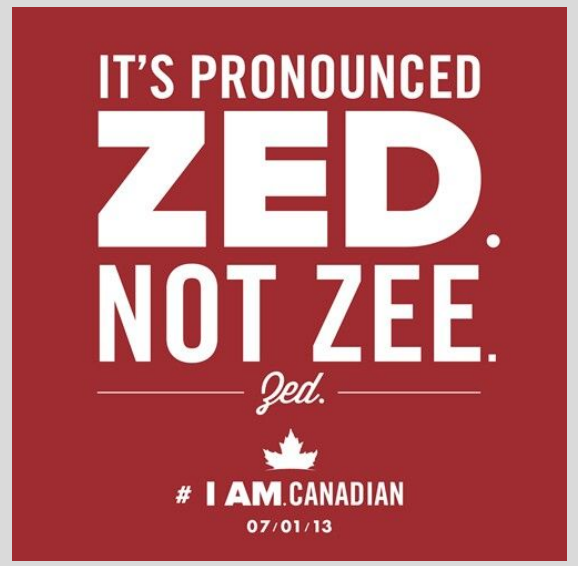
(ARTS 190)
