REMINDER - Important Border Crossing Information

IDENTIFICATION: As of June 1, 2009 you should have a valid Canadian passport. Canadian citizens should carry a birth certificate of Canadian citizenship plus one form of picture I.D. Please make sure that you travel with a valid Ontario Health Card at all times. Canadian Landed Immigrants traveling to the US must carry a valid passport with a valid non-immigrant visa, plus possess a valid PR (Permanent Resident Card) in order to return to Canada and it must be in the person's possession before boarding the coach. Entry may be refused if a valid Canadian PR card cannot be produced. You are eligible to bring back \$800 (Cdn) duty free.
