Research-Creation/Practice-Led Research

Current

Borderline (project expansion to 2025) is a research-creation project that uses the mapping and analysis of urban sound to generate critical dialogues around inequality. Using neural networks trained to identify ~100 common sounds, the project enables users to automatically tag sounds in their environment using their mobile phones, create generative soundscapes to animate uneven geographies, and export data in an open, accessible format. The project is designed to facilitate new forms of citizen engagement through radical cartographies and by listening to the ears on the ground.
