Provide documentation that demonstrates that there is a serious rift in your family and that you are estranged from one or both of your parents due to documented mental, physical, sexual, and/or emotional abuse or drug or alcohol addiction. Documentation is required before your funding can be calculated.

Section A: Required Documentation

1. A signed and dated letter detailing the family situation including:
 - the date of the final rift with your parent(s)
 - the date you left home
 - reason(s) why you are estranged from your parent(s)
 - possibility of reconciliation
 - how you have supported yourself since leaving home
 - whether or not the rift is with both parents

2. Proof of your separate residence (for example, a copy of your lease or rental agreement)

3. Written documentation from at least one professional 3rd party who was involved with the situation. Professional 3rd party includes individuals such as social workers, police officers, and/or physicians. Documentation can include police reports, court reports and/or letters from the individual. All letters must be signed by the 3rd party and include their contact information.
 If a professional 3rd party was not involved, provide letters from 2 reliable individuals who were indirectly involved. Reliable individuals are siblings, parent who was not involved in the problem/rift, grandparents, and/or other relatives. All letters must be signed by the individual and include their contact information
