

*Project Hero* was co-founded by Retired General Rick Hillier and Honorary Lieutenant-Colonel Kevin Reed to provide support to the sons and daughters of Canadian military killed while serving in an active mission. The University of Waterloo is proud to participate in *Project Hero* by providing eligible dependents with award funding to cover tuition for up to four academic years and on-campus residence and meal plan fees for the first year of study. Eligible students who have been admitted to the University of Waterloo are asked to submit an application form by June 15.

## Eligibility

To be eligible for Project Hero funding, you must be:

1. a dependent of a Canadian Forces personnel deceased while serving in an active mission
2. under the age of twenty-six
3. enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student at the University of Waterloo, in a program of study eligible for funding by the province of Ontario.

## Award Confirmation

1. Student Awards & Financial Aid at the University of Waterloo will communicate with the Director General, Personnel and Family Support Services of the National Defence to confirm eligibility to the Award program of Canadian Forces personnel deceased while serving in an active mission.
2. Dependents' status will be determined as per the Revenue Canada criteria.

## Award Value

1. The value of full-time tuition and compulsory incidental fees (including co-op fees) for the program for up to eight (8) study terms. **Refundable incidental fees will not be covered.**
2. The value of on-campus residence fees and the equivalent of an average or regular meal plan (excluding services and administrative charges) for the first year of study (two semesters).
3. The awarding of other University of Waterloo administered awards will reduce the value of the Project Hero Award dollar for dollar.

## Award Payments and Conditions

1. The Award will be listed as Anticipated Aid on your Quest account prior to the study term to allow you to make a Fee Arrangement with Student Accounts/Finance. If you do not see the Award listed as Anticipated Aid, please contact Student Awards & Financial Aid at ext. 36042 to inquire about the status of the Award.
2. If you reduce your course load or withdraw from studies, the value of the Award will be reduced or cancelled, based on standard term withdrawal deadlines.
3. If you are enrolled on a part-time basis you will not be eligible for the Award.
4. The fiscal status of the award will be in accordance with the Canadian Income Tax legislation.
