

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT CAMPUS HOUSING

Fast Facts:

- We house over 5,700 students
- Campus Housing is made up of 7 residence communities made up of 13 different buildings
- 80% of incoming first-year students live in residence
- For five consecutive terms, first-year students who lived in Campus Housing significantly outperformed their off-campus peers in their GPA.

Campus Housing offers:

Incoming first-year undergraduate housing

- Guaranteed residence for incoming first-year students who apply before June 1
- Fall contracts that line up with a student's study terms (fall/winter or fall/spring)

Upper year undergraduate housing

- Fall contracts that line up with student's study terms (fall/winter or fall/spring)
- 4-month only contracts for the winter and spring terms

Graduate student housing

- 4-month housing contracts for Grad students at Columbia Lake Village
 - Grad students have the option to renew their contract every term they remain eligible as a full time enrolled student

Family housing leases at CLV
