HOW TO REFER A STUDENT

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SUPPORT

Immigration Consulting

International students who need advice/support related to their immigration status (e.g. study permit, work permit)

- Online resources (videos, information sessions)*
- In-person and virtual appointments are available and are booked on a same-day basis through Portal
- An online webform is available for email inquiries*

International Student Programming

International students who are looking to make connections and develop a sense of community

- International Peer Community: Students can apply to participate by filling out an online form*
- Breakfast Seminars: Students can register through Portal
