We challenge you to take on the initiatives below or adopt your own initiative!



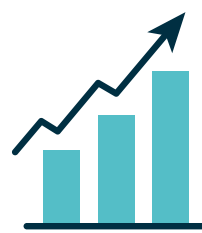
LEAD NEW RESEARCH
