Athletics Event Parking INFOsheet

This INFOsheet is intended to provide athletic event organizers using University of Waterloo facilities with an understanding of parking arrangements at UW for your event. The two main areas are parking availability, rates and enforcement. We welcome you to the University and want to make sure that parking will not be a last minute matter in planning your event. We want to help you make your event successful and enjoyable for all involved. You are encouraged to contact Parking Services staff early in your planning process.

Parking Availability

Our ability to provide convenient parking is dependent on time of year, day of week and time of day of the event. Listed below are 3 scenarios related to our capacity to provide parking. These scenarios are generalities that can be confirmed when you make your contact with us

1/ there is generally good capacity for events that start after 4 p.m. M-F and on weekends year round

- 2/ there is some capacity for day time M-F events during the spring term
- 3/ there is much less capacity during the fall and winter terms for daytime M-F events.

Parking Rates and Enforcement

Parking Services at UW is a break even business enterprise of the University and must pay all its operating and capital expenses from parking revenue. All students, staff, faculty and visitors pay for parking. Below are the normal parking rates for various lots associated with Athletic events. Arrangements can be made to have event organizers pre pay for parking for their event if they wish. Team buses are provided with complimentary parking.

Lots X, N, W, S are Pay and Display \$7.00 per day

Lot M is Pay and Display \$14.00 per day

Lot X is free 4:30 p.m Friday thru 7 a.m. Monday

We want to make your event at UW a positive one for all involved. However, pay parking, illegal street parking or other parking infractions must be enforced. Good planning in regards to Parking will reduce this. We want to avoid parking tickets and towing.
