Award description:

With the generosity of an alumnus, the Department of Systems Design Engineering at the University of Waterloo is pleased to invite applications for the Cornfield Sustainable Energy PhD Fellowship. This fellowship will address multi-scale, interconnected, highly complex, and dynamic socio technical systems.

This prestigious award provides \$120,000 over four years (\$30,000 per year). When combined with advisor support (\$10,000 per year), Faculty of Engineering support (\$5,000 per year) and one guaranteed teaching assistantship per year, the Cornfield Sustainable Energy PhD Fellows are expected to receive approximately \$50,000 of support per year.

This opportunity is open to exceptional candidates with relevant experience who want to extend their interests to advance research in this field. The department expects to award up to six fellowships in Fall 2025 and Winter 2026. The fellowship selection committee serves as the annual progress review committee that awards subsequent years of funding based on progress. More information can be found on the award website.

Eligibility and selection criteria:

Applicants must:

- Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident at the time of application
- Hold an incoming average of at least 80%
- Have applied for the Systems Design Engineering PhD program starting in Fall 2025 or Winter 2026
- Plan to research sustainable energy systems in their PhD

Instructions:

- 1. The applicant will complete their Systems Design Engineering PhD program application
- 2. The applicant will complete and sign page 2 of the fellowship application form
- 3. The applicant will submit their complete fellowship application form and the following required components <u>through the submission portal</u> by the deadline below:
 - a. A 1-page description of the applicant's experience and motivation for studying sustainable energy systems
 - b. A 1-page description of their proposed research focus/questions that will be pursued during their PhD study
 - c. A letter of support from a faculty supervisor in the Department of Systems Design Engineering, who agrees to provide the Faculty of Engineering minimum guaranteed PhD funding
 - d. Transcripts from prior graduate studies (students applying to PhD without a master's must include undergraduate transcripts)
