The late T.E. Unny contributed significantly to the development of stochastic and statistical methods in hydrology and environmental engineering during his long and distinguished career. During his career as a professor in Civil Engineering and Systems Design Engineering at the University of Waterloo (1965-1991), Dr. Unny supervised many graduate students. To celebrate his lifelong accomplishments and memory, the Dr. T.E. Unny Memorial Award was established in 1993.

Purpose:

The purpose of this award is to provide financial support for graduate students in the Faculty of Engineering who are working in the field of **stochastic and statistical methods in hydrology and environmental engineering**.
