Professor Lisa Aultman-Hall is seeking a Postdoctoral Fellow for a 2-year appointment to advance research on:

- Electric vehicle (EV) charging behavior
- Long-distance intercity travel in Canada

Both projects involve travel survey data analysis and choice modeling. The EV-focused research uses stated preference data to explore pricing strategies for away-from-home charging to simulate charging infrastructure scenarios with price signals in the Greater Toronto—Hamilton Area. The long-distance travel project includes spatial analysis of trip records in Statistics Canada's National Travel Survey using a nation-wide transportation network model.

Responsibilities include:

- Statistical analysis of large survey datasets
- Developing and applying choice models
- Spatial analysis to measure intercity accessibility
- Contributing to scenario simulations and policy-relevant insights
- Preparing co-authored journal publications
- Mentoring undergraduate co-op and graduate students

- Strong quantitative and modeling skills
- Experience with survey data, GIS and discrete choice analysis
