5 Criteria for Qualifications		Evidence of Eligibility
1.	Be a faculty member at the professorial rank at the University of Waterloo (this includes clinical faculty).	
2.	Normally hold a PhD degree or a terminal degree in field.	
3.	Demonstrate continuing competence and achievement in research or scholarship appropriate for the discipline.	
4.	Demonstrate appropriate familiarity with University of Waterloo policies and procedures on PhD supervision. This is preferably achieved by the faculty member attending a University-provided workshop or receiving training on supervisory procedures at the Faculty level.	
5.	 Demonstrate appropriate supervisory experience: this can be achieved by the faculty member choosing one of the following: Successfully completing a workshop series organized by the office of the Associate Provost, Graduate Studies and facilitated by CTE on graduate supervision, over the course of one year; Successfully supervising to completion at least one Master's thesis; Having co-supervised or supervised a PhD thesis to completion (see Guidelines for Best Practice in Co-Supervision).
