Have you waited the full length of your OSAP Academic Restriction period and would like to be reinstated into the OSAP program?

Yes, sign and date this from and upload to your current OSAP application to request a review for clearance of your OSAP restriction. No other documentation is required.

No, if you are currently restricted from OSAP because you were unable to meet OSAP academic progress requirements because of personal circumstances beyond your control, you may be eligible to appeal your OSAP Academic Restriction. **Acceptable circumstances and required documentation include the following:**

Student Letter is required

 A letter explaining why you are requesting this appeal and an explanation of the circumstances beyond your control for the term(s) related to your OSAP Academic Restriction.

Additional documentation is required based on your circumstances:

Medical Condition

- Documentation from a physician confirming that your ability to participate in post-secondary studies was restricted for a portion of, or the entire study period. Dates of illness or injury must be included.
- Documentation that shows you are now well enough to continue studies on a full-time basis.

Disability

- Please outline in the student letter if the disability was undiagnosed or previously diagnosed prior to the start of the study period related to the OSAP Academic Restriction.
- If previously undiagnosed you may include medical documentation confirming date of diagnosis.
- If previously diagnosed, your student letter needs to explain what supports and/or accommodations you accessed, and if not, the reason for not seeking/receiving those supports. This can include an outline of the support and strategies you have in place to address your disability-related needs for academic success (e.g. registered with AccessAbility Services, asked for advice from your academic advisor, etc.)

Family Crisis

- A letter from a third party confirming the dates of the event and circumstances.
- Additional third-party documentation as applicable, such as insurance documents, police reports, eviction notices, documentation from daycares, schools, travel documents, death certificates, medical records, documentation from a petition.
