



Goshen College invites applications for a full-time appointment as **Director for the Institute for the Study of Global Anabaptism which includes Directing the Mennonite Historical Library** and **Assistant or Associate Professor of History** with expertise in Anabaptist-Mennonite studies, starting July 2022.

The Director of the Institute of the Study of Global Anabaptism (ISGA) provides oversight to programs of the institute and the Mennonite Historical Library (MHL). They will lead new initiatives in student engagement, research and internships through ISGA, scholarly and pedagogical innovations that benefit Goshen College's undergraduates broadly, and connect ISGA's work to Goshen College's strengths in community engaged learning. This position reports directly to the VP for Academic Affairs. In addition, the successful candidate will serve the needs of the college's CORE in religion and interculturality every year, and may teach upper-level History courses in their area of expertise and in Anabaptist-Mennonite Studies.

The successful candidate will be able to demonstrate strengths in organization, program development, scholarship and teaching. This position will be approximately 75% oversight of the ISGA and MHL and 25% teaching. In addition to teaching, the position includes advising and mentoring an increasingly culturally, racially and religiously diverse student body, full participation in the department, and the mentoring of Goshen College's faculty in integrating our mission of *“academic excellence and real-world experience with active love for God and neighbor in the Anabaptist-Mennonite tradition.”*
