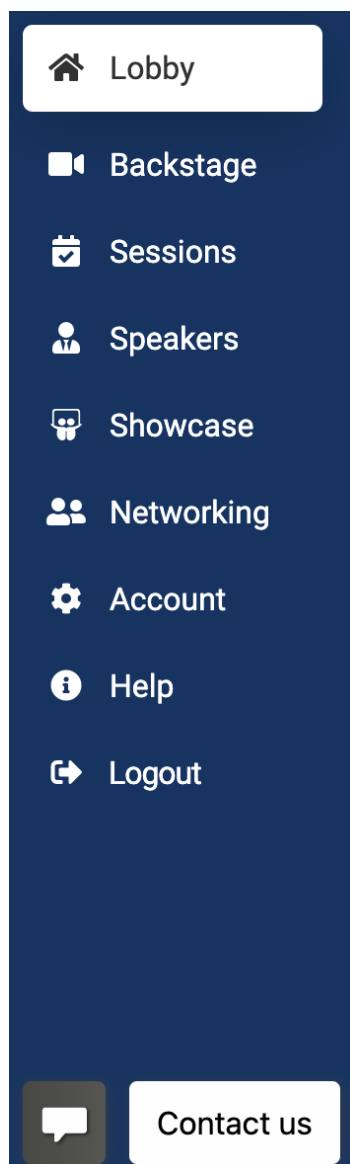

Supported Browsers and Devices

The optimal setup for PheedLoop is using Google Chrome on a laptop or desktop with an internet connection that offers at least 5 Mbps download speed. Other supported browsers include Mozilla Firefox and Apple Safari. Laptop and desktop devices are recommended to ensure you can participate in all aspects of the conference.



Getting Started

1. You will receive an email from <no-reply@pheedloop.com> titled “Virtual Event Portal Access.” This will contain your account’s email, temporary password, and a button labeled “Visit Virtual Portal” to access the conference site for the first time.
2. Once you are logged into the UWTL 2022 Conference site, you can change your password under “Account”. You can access the conference site from now on using <https://pheedloop.com/uwtl2022/> and entering your email address and password.

Troubleshooting

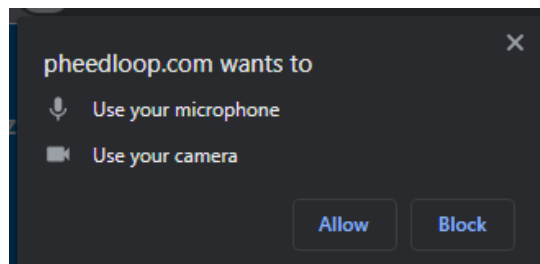
If you are having issues accessing PheedLoop, we suggest:

1. Using a different browser
2. Accessing the site in a private/incognito window in your browser
3. Disabling any operating system level VPNs (Virtual Private Network) or firewalls which may be blocking a specific website
4. If all else fails, try restarting your computer.

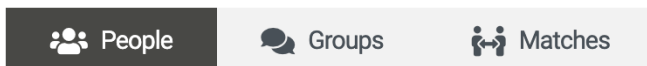
Allowing PheedLoop to Access Your Microphone and Camera

The first time you enter a session or access Networking you will be prompted to allow PheedLoop to use your camera and microphone. Click Allow to proceed.



Networking

If you want to connect with your colleagues throughout the conference, explore the Networking tab. You can access open networking groups to chat with other conference attendees under **Groups** (taking place during breaks in the conference). **Matches** allow you to answer a few questions regarding your role and interests in teaching and learning, and then have PheedLoop identify other colleagues who share similar interests.



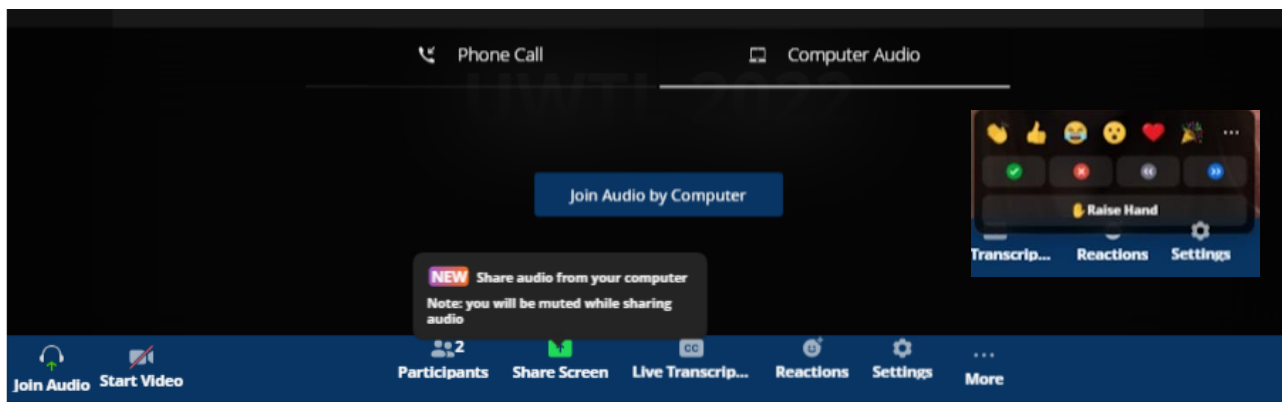
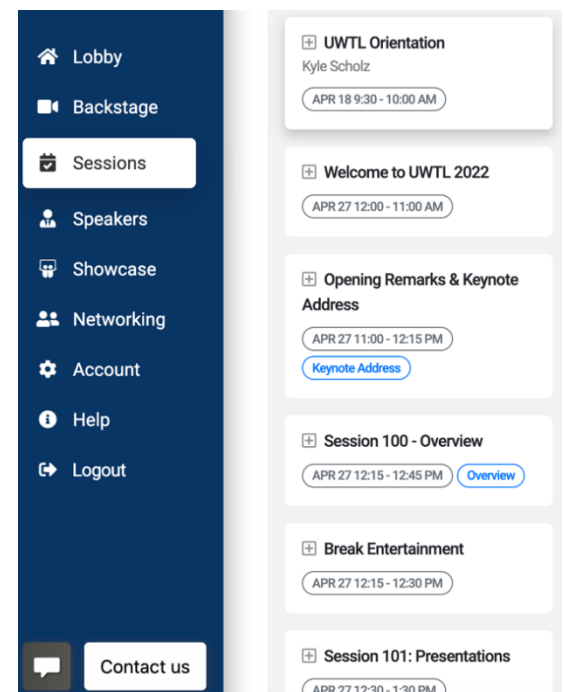
Accessing Sessions and Using Zoom in PheedLoop

Click on the **Sessions** menu. Find and click on the session you will be attending.

When you enter the session before its start time, you will see a message that the session will begin soon. The session will automatically begin at the start time listed. Presentations will begin with pre-recorded presentations, followed by a live Q&A period in Zoom, whereas panels or workshops will begin in Zoom immediately. When the Zoom session begins, you will be asked to 'Join Audio by Computer' in order to hear the presenters and ask your own questions.

There will be different functions available to use including mute/unmute audio, start/turn off video, and enabling live transcription.

Please keep your audio muted during sessions unless otherwise instructed by the facilitator/speaker.



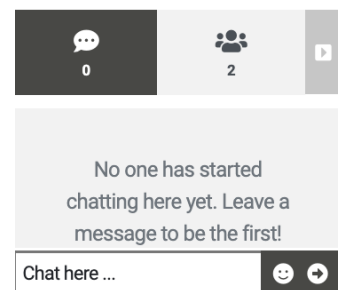
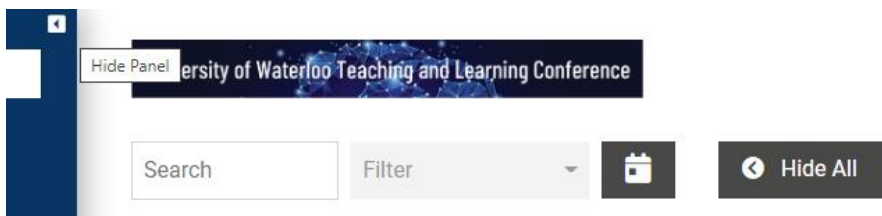
Under **Reactions**, you can access various reactions (such as raising your hand).
