



Diane Jules, CPA, CGMA is the Deputy Director of the International Ethics Standards Board for Accountants (IESBA). Since assuming the role in 2016, Ms. Jules has worked diligently to advance the strategic goals and priorities of the IESBA.

Ms. Jules is integral to the development of enhancements to ethics and independence standards for global application and partners with the IESBA Board members, including the Chairman to promote awareness, use and adoption of the [International Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants \(including International Independence Standards\)](#). She is a highly sought-after presenter, speaking regularly to various groups and service-based professionals about the global ethics and auditor independence developments.

Ms. Jules oversees many of the IESBA's key projects, including Technology. Following the successful development and June 2019 launch of the [IESBA eCode](#) — a digital platform for accessing and navigating the Code— Ms. Jules is now a member of IFAC's Digitization Initiative Advisory Group.

Prior to joining the IESBA, Ms. Jules was a Senior Technical Manager at the IAASB, and before that an Assistant Chief Auditor at the U.S. Public Company Accounting Oversight Board (PCAOB). During her time on the IAASB, Ms. Jules was a principal drafter of [the revisions to the International Standards on Auditing \(ISAs\) relating to the New Auditor's Report](#) which became effective in December 2016. At the PCAOB, Ms. Jules worked on the PCAOB Auditing Standards related to [auditors' risk assessment](#) and developed recommendations related to professional skepticism and auditor reporting. Prior to her career in standard-setting, Ms. Jules held various audit and professional practice positions, including as an Assurance Manager at Grant Thornton, LLP.

Named as one of Crain's New York Business 77 [Notable Women in Accounting and Consulting](#) in 2019, Ms. Jules has been featured industry publications, including the Strategic Finance Magazine and the Journal of Accountancy. She conducts editorial reviews on technical submissions to the [Advances in Accounting Education: Teaching and Curriculum Innovations Series](#) and the [CPA Journal](#).

Ms. Jules is also an active member of the American Institute of CPAs and the New York State Society of CPAs (NYSSCPA). She is the current Vice Chair of the NYSSCPA *Accounting and Auditing Oversight Committee*, a member of the NYSSCPA *Professional Ethics Committee*, and is a former Chair of the NYSSCPA *International Accounting and Auditing Committee*. Ms. Jules holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Accounting and Finance from the University of Maryland College Park (UMCP). She is also a certified public accountant (CPA) and a chartered global management accountant (CGMA).
