






### Develop an engaging message

- Problem the part of the larger issue you are addressing
- So What why should your audience care?
- Solutions options to solve the problem

### **DEVELOPING A STRONG LIGHTNING TALK**



#### Have a strong hook

- Take the first 20 seconds to engage the audience
- Avoid: "Hi my name is Nancy" as your opener
- Try: "Every year, the algal blooms in Lake Erie cause a myriad of problems that interfere with citizen's enjoyment of the lake including swimming, fishing and boating. My name is Nancy Goucher and I'm going to tell you what my team is doing to support research about this problem."

### **Practical tips**

- Create an outline or script
- Avoid the details
- Know your audience
- Be confident
- Time yourself ahead of time


