- Updated schema in Nexus to support LAPS as defined in the change request. Noted the .DIT (database) file size before and after for both Nexus and Apex and noted no difference. Perhaps when values are actually assigned to some attributes a change will be noted, but even then it should be trivial.
- Do all want the SharePoint additions applied to the top of the “People” OU?
- W10 Education is here and experience is growing. Went to great lengths to make sure we are deploying the correct version and emailed out the reasoning for the final decision.
 - Can not “upgrade” apps from W7 or W8.1 Enterprise to W10 Education, but can migrate data. (We don’t tend to support upgrades anyway. A rebuild is preferred.)
 - Have W10 VDIs available for anyone that wishes to try it out (via RDP)
 - IST WSUS has been upgraded to support W10

- IST KMS server has been upgraded to support W10
- SCCM is still in progress, as significant changes exist. For the time being the SCCM GPO does not deploy a client to W10 workstations. (It wouldn't work anyway.)
- Distribution via Webstore is working out very well! People seem to like this approach
- VDI:
 - Offering 90 Finance workstations to staff across campus to do Enterprise Business Systems (EBS) work. Doing this on primary workstations has become a security risk do to outdated versions of Java and IE. These VDI workstations are restricted to intranet only, freeing up the ability to get primary workstations up-to-date.
 - Offering 400 copies of Taxprep to Arts for a course this fall. Will monitor performance in order to get a measure of how much we can challenge the current infrastructure, before having to supplement it with more hardware.
 - Still offering SPSS to AHS. Turns out licensing is restricted to lab workstations, not people! Not good.
- 130+ Podium PCs were rebuilt Sunday night. Two had to be powered up Monday morning. Otherwise no problems.

IST – Security Mike

- Upgrading one of the undergrad labs with new thin clients. We are deploying Windows 7 based thin clients instead of ThinPro based.

Math – Hari

- Retired 2 oldest undergrad terminal servers, added one new terminal server. Now, all undergrad terminal servers have 10G connectivity. We are using NLB and RD Session Broker for connection and load balancing. NLB with multicast setting didn't work with our Dell network blades as they wouldn't allow ARP entry with unicast IP address and multicast MAC address. So, we used 2 network adapters in place of single and configured unicast NLB which works better.
- Upgrading common apps. We will be using SCCM for common apps instead of GPO which we used till now.
