Additional Notes

Manfred's notes for "Workstation Services – IST":

- Still on track to deploy W10 to AS starting Feb 27th
 - Identified 2353 active PCs in AS (2961 in Nexus)
 - Round one will be focusing on desktops only – laptops and VMs will be tackled later
 - We have 526 VMs and laptops
 - Have three classes of PCs identified in round one:
 1. Confidence "High"
 - Mostly "Desktop Rollover PCs" where hardware vendors have offered W10 drivers (i.e. W10 supported)
 - Last count we had 1352 in this class
 - These have all drivers included in SCCM (so only the driver set needed is downloaded by PC)
 - Models include:

 - Dell 990, 3030, 7040, 9010, 9020
- 2. Confidence “Medium”
 - PCs we know W10 will work on but not necessarily vendor supported (for W10)
 - This will be a difference task sequence with and image that is 5GB larger, with about 100 known driver models supported
 - Driver list too long to list here
- 3. The rest
 - Some of these can't run W10 as no drivers have been found
 - Also includes PCs like Dell 745s and 755s that we have drivers for but don't wish to migrate forward
 - Includes about 476 PCs
 - As we gain experience (or departmental pleas), PC types may move from class 3 to class 2
- Plan to start by putting a standing advertisement onto all PCs we have hardware driver confidence in – This will allow all with PCs that are eligible to upgrade on their own schedule
- Will focus on IST first and make the deployment there mandatory after three weeks
- Are already working with other departments and proceeding on their schedules
- Wireless PC management
 - Are finishing off testing of a client “opt-in” model for wireless management
 - Including all of Eduroam into the site boundary for SCCM is perceived as potentially dangerous
 - Are therefore allowing clients to add their PC names to a security group which will put them into a difference VLAN when they sign in (which is in the SCCM site boundary)
 - Still deciding on having clients userids put into a second security group, in case we wish further isolation
 - Clients say they wish their PCs to be managed while wireless, but we need to prepare them for what that really means by documenting this properly
