- The W10 deployment to AS has started with IST targeted with a standing advertisement now, with a mandatory deployment scheduled for March 21st. 119 IST PCs already have W10 v1607, with 111 left to go. (1678 total in Nexus.)
- Heads up from the W10/Office 2016 project, to those considering 64-bit Office with their W10 deployments: 64-bit Office has issues with SharePoint and other Web Platforms that still utilize 32-Bit controls for ActiveX via the Browser. An Office install installs a whole host of additional features and add-ons for integrating with a full Office ecosystem, not just Word and Excel. This will likely cause additional web technology support issues and likely cause odd interactions.
- IST is building an MBAM (Microsoft Bitlocker Administration and Monitoring) server with the intent of centrally managing laptop encryption for anyone on campus wishing to participate. This, along with Nexus GPOs will give us an easier way to remotely manage Bitlocker and generate required compliance reports. (This is particularly important after/during the current W10 deployments as laptops need to be re-encrypted.)
- IST changed its W10 image building process as a result of discovered IE11 and OneDrive permission problems. We also noticed a userid and profile Microsoft “left behind” called “defaultuser0”. It's not clear what it's used for but when we searched, it appears many are deleting it. It's now been deleted from our new image.
