IST WS – Hong

- We have a few cases that OnedriverSetup.exe is taking too much CPU resource and slow down the system. The Onedrive setup files reside in AppData\Local\Microsoft. Since we have disabled roaming profiles and UEV doesn't roam these settings, the problem happens randomly when users log in different systems. There are ways to fix this problem by individual users. <https://www.itechtics.com/2-ways-fix-onedrivesetup-causes-high-cpu-usage/>
No sure if we can find a solution to centrally manage these settings for all users.
- IST workstation and corp. app groups have started to test Win 10 1803.
- Is Sendit still the best solution to share large files? Other solutions? Some of us have found Sendit is very browser picky.

IST CS - Lisa

- 1803: We have begun the process for upgrading all AS machines to 1803. Expected deadline for full deployment is July 24th
- MBAM: We are expanding MBAM into Housing, and have MBAM documentation completed for IST Acct Reps/Service Desk. We expect to have full compliance by the end of the summer term.
