Background

- Research "areas of expertise" web page was just a text list
 - no ability to convert users
 - no gateway to further content
 - no proof of expertise/strengths
 - no lead capture mechanism

- Faculty profiles project 2015
- Research categories taxonomy review
 - Industry Canada, Tri Council, OUAC,
 Thomson Reuters



Analysis

- Web analytics (Sept 1 Dec 1):
 - 20 % click traffic on uwaterloo.ca/engineering-research go to "areas of expertise" page next
 - Average time on page is 01:33 (high for no conversion options)
 - 22% opt to exit
 - 17% went back to research entry page
 - 16% navigate back and exit to centres/institutes
 - 13% navigate back and exit to departments



Challenges & opportunities

- Information about research strengths exists, but is scattered among many sources
- Need to avoid duplicating content
- Need to point to & leverage source content
- Need to provide conversion options and lead capture



Solution: Custom WCMS Single Page

- Why?
 - Capture leads and nurture (salesforce)
 - Direct user to critical content
 - Encourage users to complete a task/take action (registration, form completion, use search tool)
 - Easy to optimize and promote with digital marketing campaigns



Next Steps: Project Plan

- Consultation with Graduate Recruitment, Engineering Research and Dean
- Budget: \$20,000
- Itemize and prioritize development requirements
- Hire external Drupal Developer
- Engineering Computing support for OFIS integration

- Web form block
- OFIS search and results block
- Video banner
- Dynamic anchoring for CTA panel (provide more app like/game interaction on mobile)
- Salesforce integration
