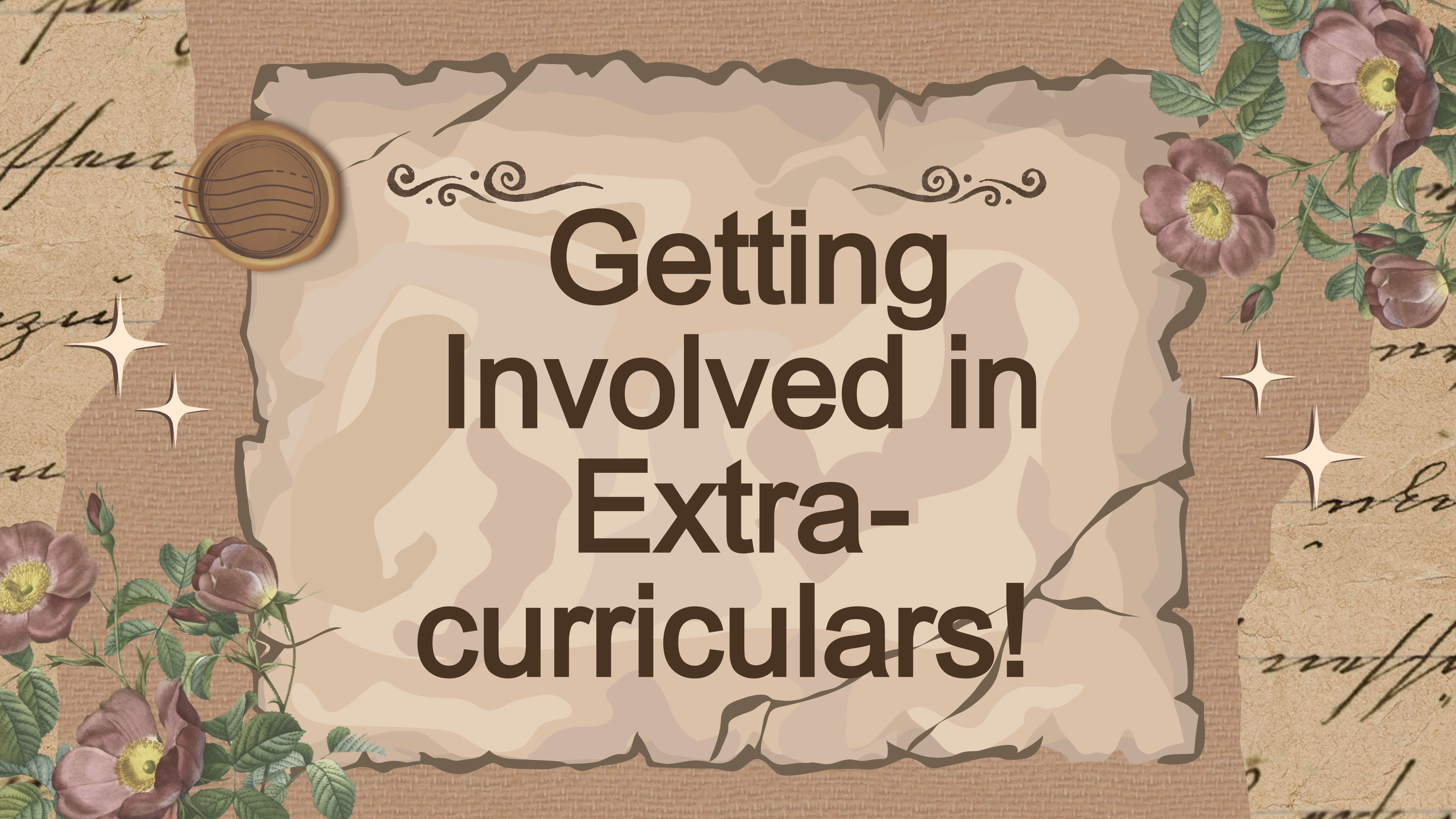
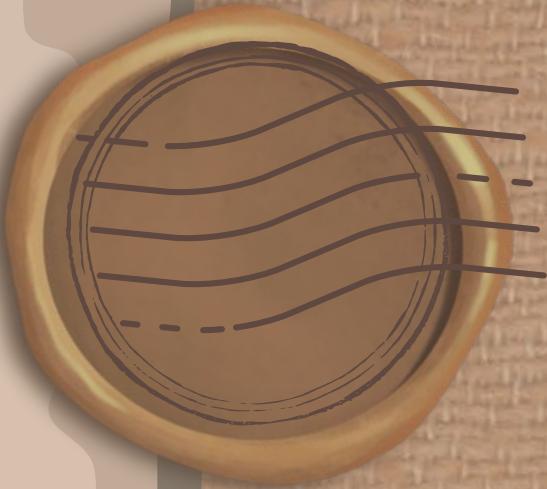

- Have fun: This is your time, so make the most of it!

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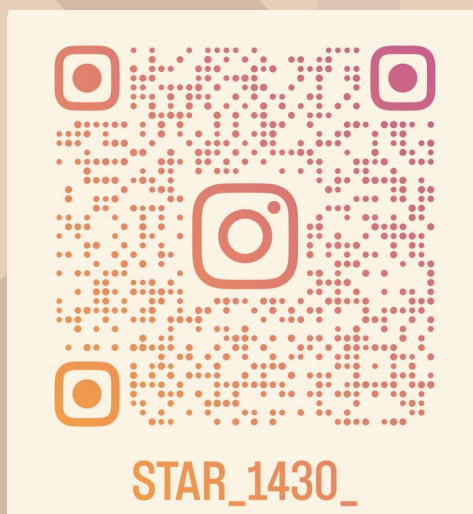
