


I used <u>UWFlow</u> to upload my class schedule to GC, and I added all of my weekly meetings and upcoming events




Notion

I use <u>Notion</u> to keep track of all of my weekly assignments. I make daily to do lists to know what I need to accomplish for that day








Experiment



You will have something going on outside of school


