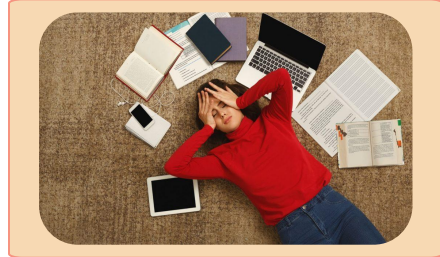
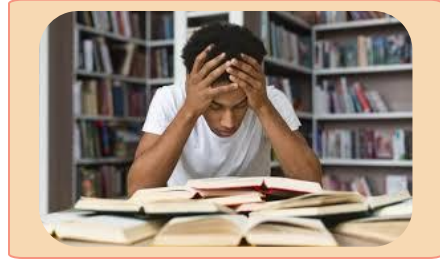
Experiment

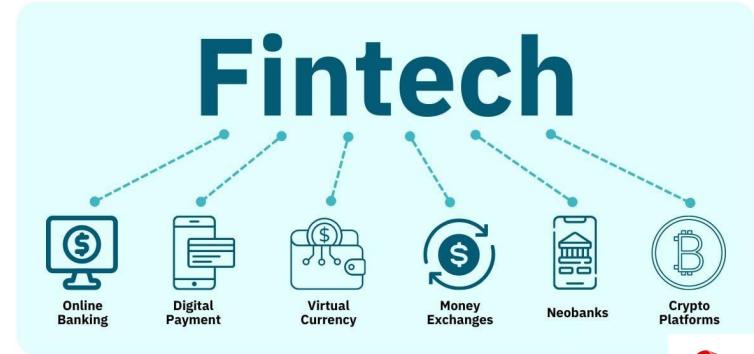

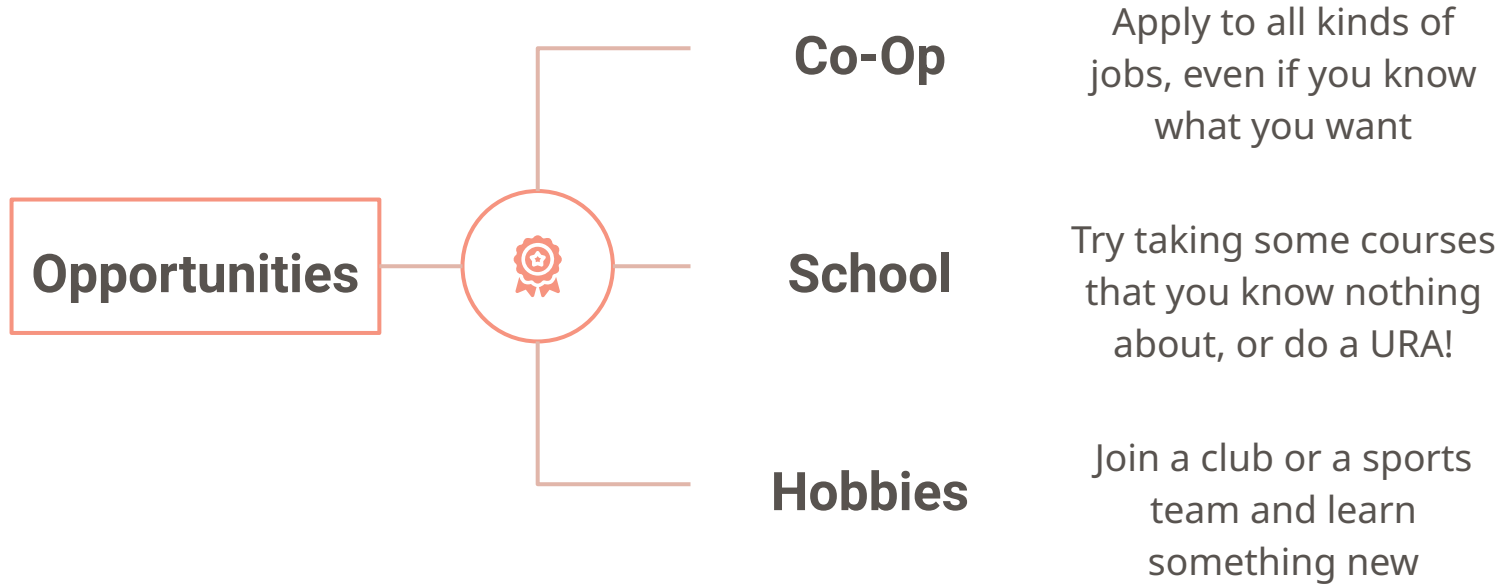

You will have something going on outside of school

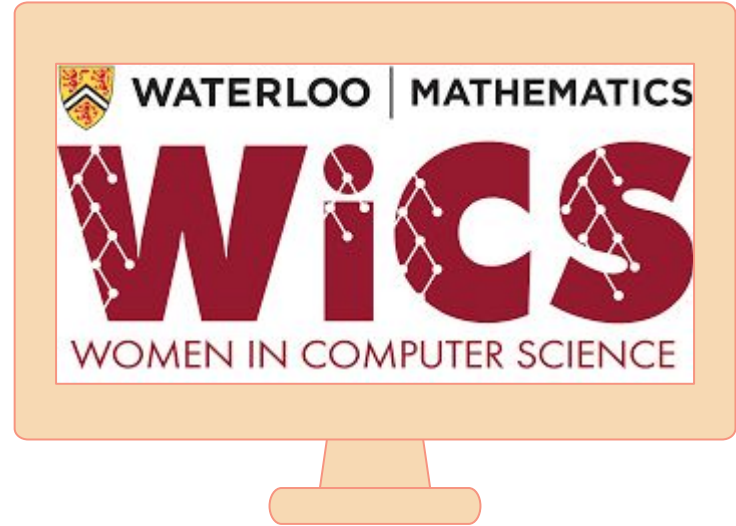


Destress

WiCS is a great student-led organization to be a part of, so you're all on the right track!





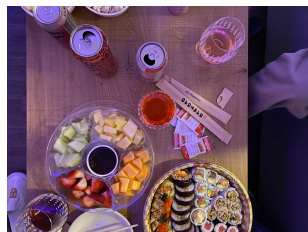
