What do Academic Advisers do?

- Academic advisors assist students with course selection, degree requirements and academic challenges.
- Help you with providing campus resources.
- Contact if you have questions about University policies, procedures, and possible exceptions.

1. Faculty advisors

For help with academic concerns within the faculty. Each focuses on specific majors, minors and certificates in the faculty

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2. Co-op Advisors

They will guide you through the entire co-op process, from applying for jobs to navigating interviews and supporting you during your work terms.

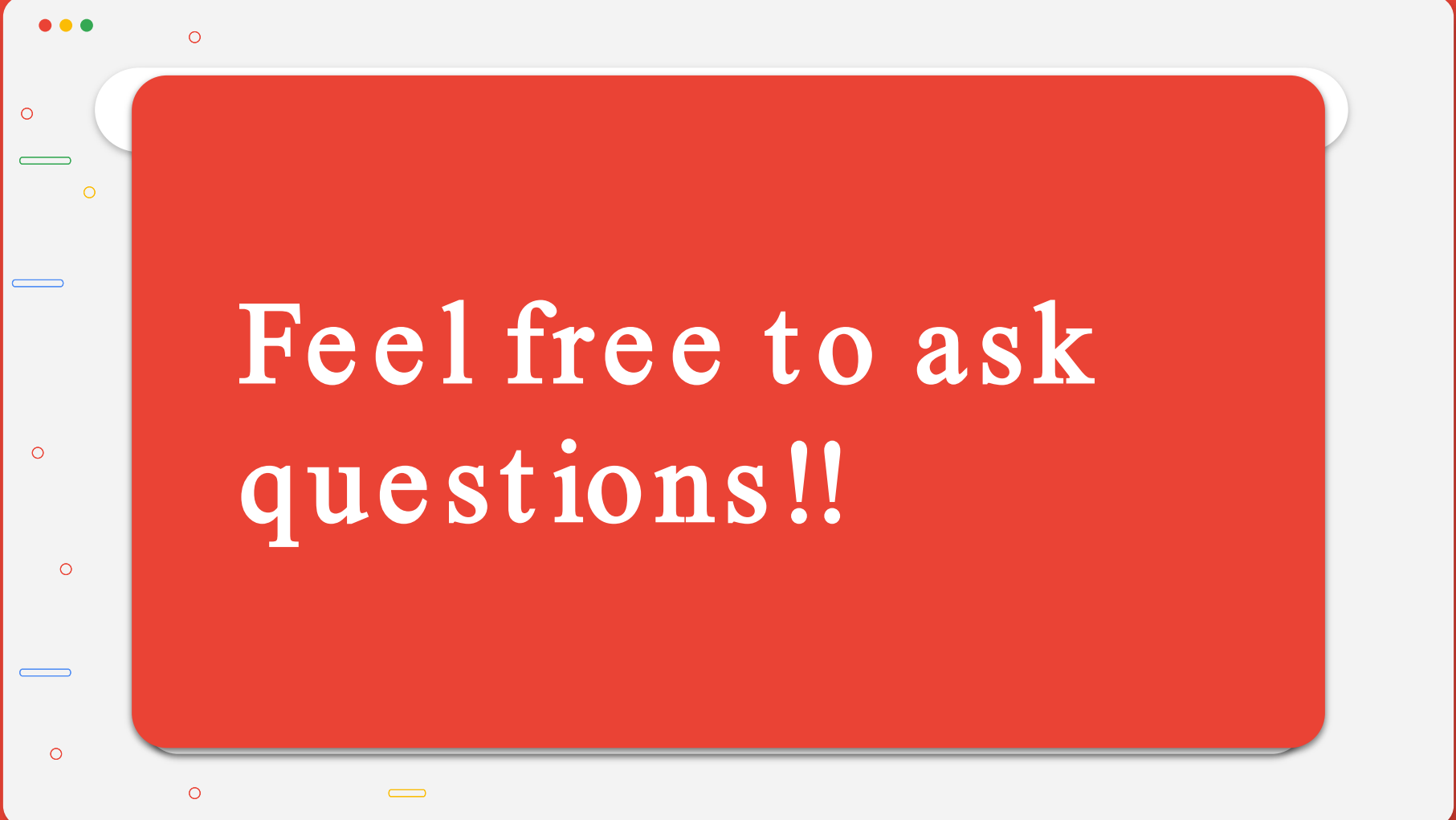
1. Online portals and websites

2. Physical locations

- **Student Success Office (SSO):** Located at South Campus Hall, where students can walk in for advice, workshops, or coaching.
- **Counselling Services:** Located in Needles Hall North, where students can receive in-person mental health support.
- **AccessAbility Services:** Found in Needles Hall as well, offering walk-in support for accessibility accommodations.
- **Faculty-Specific Advising Offices:** Every faculty has advising offices across campus, with advisors ready to assist in academic guidance.
