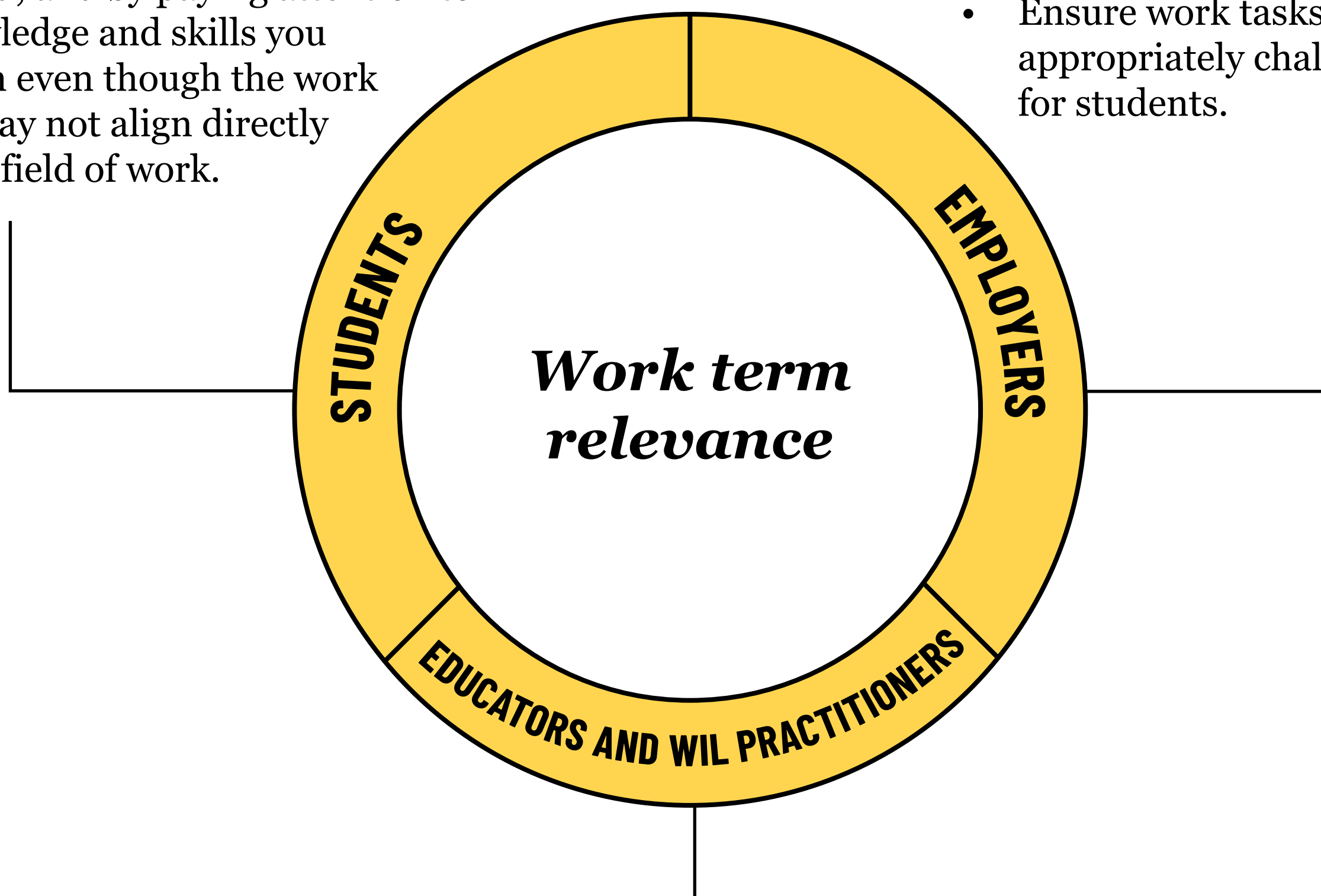


HOW CAN EDUCATORS, EMPLOYERS AND STUDENTS WORK TOWARDS RELEVANT WORK-INTEGRATED LEARNING EXPERIENCES?

- Be open-minded to experiences that may be relevant in different ways, like learning through experience what industries and roles are not for you, and by paying attention to new knowledge and skills you can obtain even though the work context may not align directly with your field of work.

- Strengthen your onboarding process to provide opportunities for social integration (e.g. mentorship programs).
- Ensure work tasks are appropriately challenging for students.



- Highlight the importance of socialization to students and employers. For example, encourage students to ask questions and get to know their colleagues during their work term.
- Consult employers and students on what makes a work term valuable and relevant.
