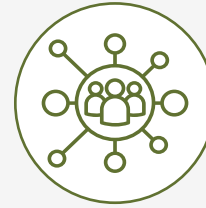


COLLABORATIVE WRITING:

Promote Equity

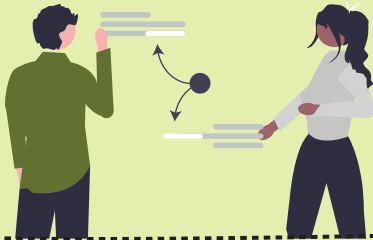
Recognize young people's contributions fairly, creating a sense of ownership and inclusion.

HOW TO GET STARTED



Step 1: Engage Contributors

Step 3: Collaborate

Break the process into manageable phases: share data, refine insights, draft manuscripts, and incorporate feedback.
